Update to Intravascular Lithotripsy (IVL)

Updates have been made to Chapter 19, Peripheral Interventions, Intravascular Lithotripsy (IVL), Pages 363 and 364. The reference for percutaneous transluminal coronary lithotripsy and the example have been updated and can be seen below in red.

The original reference version:

"For physician services reporting, there is no listed CPT® code for this procedure, so unlisted procedure code 37799 should be reported for IVL of non-coronary arteries. See code +0715T for percutaneous transluminal coronary lithotripsy."

It now reads:

For physician services reporting, there is no listed CPT® code for this procedure, so unlisted procedure code 37799 should be reported for IVL of non-coronary arteries. See code +92972 for percutaneous transluminal coronary lithotripsy.

The original example:



EXAMPLE

Via left common femoral puncture, the physician performs lithotripsy with stenting of the right internal iliac artery, with angioplasty in the right external artery.

Hospital: 37220, C9765

Physician: 37220, 33779

No separate catheter placement code would be reported in this case since the external iliac and internal iliac arteries are at the same degree of selectivity for both interventions.

It now reads:



EXAMPLE

Via left common femoral puncture, the physician performs lithotripsy with stenting of the right internal iliac artery, and angioplasty without lithotripsy in the right external artery.

Hospital: C9765, 37220-59 or XS

Physician: 33779, 37220

Although a bundling edit exists between C9765 and 37220, a modifier is allowed in the edit pair and appropriate in this case to report the transluminal angioplasty without IVL in a separate vessel. No separate catheter placement code would be reported in this case since the external iliac and internal iliac arteries are at the same degree of selectivity for both interventions.
